### **FIOLET CLAIMS FREIGHT FIRST WITH P&O FERRIES**

Truck driver Jason Godden made a little history when he became the first freight customer to board P&O Ferries' brand new £150 million Dover – Calais ship *Spirit of France*.

Jason is pictured being welcomed by Chris Laming, communications director of P&O Ferries, and Lorraine Lyons, customer operations controller, who presented him with a commemorative certificate and bottle of champagne.

Jason, from Chingford, Essex, is just two weeks into a new job, driving for JC Fiolet.

*Spirit of France* is the sister to *Spirit of Britain*, which P&O Ferries launched on the Dover – Calais route last year. At 47,500 tonnes the ships are by far the largest ever built for the Dover Strait, with space for up to 170 lorries.
